## Fact Sheet

- Date:** Saturday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010
- Time:** **Judging: 10:00 – 11:00am**  
**17 & Under: 11:00am**  
**18+: Immediately following the 17 & under**
- Event:** The Cardboard Classic, Steamboat's traditional rite of spring returns to the Steamboat Ski Area for the 30<sup>th</sup> year. This wild and hilarious race features homemade cardboard crafts, constructed only from cardboard, glue, string, water based paint, duct tape and masking tape, racing down Stampede to a hysterical finish. The uniqueness and creativity of the race make it an event looked forward to each year.
- Where:** On Stampede at the Base of the Steamboat Ski Area, drop of area is at the Ptarmigan Inn
- Registration:** Entry forms with all participant liability waivers will be accepted through Friday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 or until maximum capacity (50 crafts). All participants must have signed a release waiver and these must be turned in as a complete packet in order to be registered. Registration packets are available in the Information Center in Gondola Square at the base of the ski resort (open daily 8am -5pm) or online at [steamboat.com/spring](http://steamboat.com/spring) \$10 Entry Fee due at check-in on April 10<sup>th</sup> from 9 - 10:30am
- Eligibility:** Open, Limit 50 crafts so register EARLY!!!
- Rules:** *Only items allowed for the cardboard crafts include: glue, string, cardboard, water-based paint, duct tape, masking tape and packing tape.*  
No more than 6 people per craft.  
No children under 5 years of age allowed in crafts.  
An adult must accompany children 5-10 years old.  
Everyone entered must complete an entry form/release waiver before being allowed to register, those who are 17 & under will need a guardian to sign a liability waiver on their behalf.  
All event participants must have their bib/credential in order to be able to participate.  
No alcoholic beverages within the race arena – disqualification will be immediate.

10:00am-11am: Cardboard D'Elegance/Judging  
11am: 17 & under race begins – crafts run on a first come, first serve basis  
Immediately following: 18+ race begins – crafts run on a first come, first serve basis  
Award Ceremony will follow the end of race at Bear River Bar & Grill
- Prizes:** Everyone who enters the race will be eligible for a drawing for a 2010/2011 Steamboat Season Pass. Other prizes may be awarded at random. Prizes are non-refundable and are not for sale.

**STEAMBOAT SKI & RESORT CORP. CARDBOARD BOX DERBY PARTICIPANT 2010 RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.**

"ADULT" means the undersigned adult Steamboat special event participant, being at least 18 years old, signing on behalf of himself/herself and/or the undersigned parent(s) or legal guardian(s), being at least 18 years old, signing on behalf of the minor named below so that the minor will be permitted to engage in special event activities described herein. "MINOR" means the minor participant named below. "Undersigned" means the ADULT and MINOR collectively. The person actually taking part in the special event activities is referred to herein as "Participant". Undersigned agrees and understands that participating in a Cardboard Derby event, including skiing and cardboard derby competitions, demonstrations, and performances and/or any other uses of the facilities, activities, or equipment of Steamboat Resort ("Resort"), or such other venue as may be utilized by the Resort, (the "ACTIVITIES") can be **HAZARDOUS**. **The Undersigned understands that Participant will not be permitted to take part in the ACTIVITIES unless this Warning, Assumption of Risk, Liability Release, Hold Harmless and Indemnity Agreement ("Agreement") is fully executed.**

UNDERSIGNED AGREES AND UNDERSTANDS THAT AS A PARTICIPANT IN THE ACTIVITIES, ANY MINOR CHILD OF PARTICIPANT WILL NOT BE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OR CONTROL OF THE RESORT. UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THAT PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES IS ENTIRELY VOLUNTARY AND THAT NO EMPLOYEE OF STEAMBOAT OR ANY RELATED ENTITY IS REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ACTIVITIES. PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES DOES NOT CONSTITUTE EMPLOYMENT AND IS NOT PART OF PARTICIPANT'S EMPLOYMENT OR WORK OBLIGATIONS FOR PURPOSES OF THE "WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT OF COLORADO" AND UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTANDS THAT PARTICIPANT IS NOT ENTITLED TO BENEFITS PURSUANT TO SUCH ACT FOR ANY INJURIES RESULTING FROM OR OCCURRING DURING THE ACTIVITIES.

Undersigned is advised and understands that under Colorado law a person who is sliding or jumping on snow or ice using skis, a snowboard, sled, toboggan, tube or snowbike or any other device or using any of the facilities of a ski area is considered a "skier" and certain risks and dangers of "skiing" are addressed by Colorado law. **ADULT ACKNOWLEDGES AND UNDERSTANDS THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT ADULT FOR HIM/HER SELF AND, IF APPLICABLE, ON BEHALF OF MINOR, IS ASSUMING RISKS, WAIVING RIGHTS AND RELEASING CLAIMS IN ADDITION TO THOSE ADDRESSED BY COLORADO LAW.**

Undersigned understands and agrees that participation in the ACTIVITIES is dangerous and can be EXTREMELY DANGEROUS, that there are no completely safe ways to ride a piece of cardboard or a craft constructed of cardboard, particularly on snow or ice, and that cardboard crafts do not stop easily and may be extremely difficult to steer. Further, Undersigned acknowledges that the **risks and dangers** of the ACTIVITIES may be increased by a variety of factors, including, but not limited to: the number of participants and spectators, variable and changing surface conditions, marked and unmarked obstacles, rugged mountainous terrain, conditions and design of the course and finish area, snow, ice, sun, wind, fog and other weather conditions, natural and man-made obstacles, the condition and construction of Participant's craft and crafts of other participants, the actions of Participant, spectators and other participants directly or indirectly involved in the ACTIVITIES, dehydration, fatigue, and acts of God. Undersigned understands that he/she could be injured by the craft itself or some part of it, and by the way the craft was designed and constructed. Undersigned acknowledges that injuries have occurred in cardboard derbies before and that injuries are possible. This list is not an exclusive or exhaustive list of possible risks, dangers, injuries, or accidents that may occur while participating in the ACTIVITIES. Undersigned is warned that the risk of injuries increases to the extent that participants have used drugs and/or alcohol, do not observe craft construction guidelines or regulations and/or are not physically capable of participating in the ACTIVITIES.

Undersigned acknowledges and agrees that he/she has been informed of and understands and agrees to obey all instructions and rules and posted signs and warnings including instructions on the use of lifts. Participant agrees that he/she will obey those signs and warnings located on the property or at any facility or premises of the Resort and to obey instructions from Resort staff. Undersigned understands that Participant must have the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload the lifts, load and unload the craft and ride the craft in the competition. Undersigned assumes the risks of riding the lifts and engaging in activities accessible from the lifts including the ACTIVITIES. Undersigned is advised that snowmobiles, snowmaking, snow-grooming and other equipment or vehicles may be encountered at any time and that Participant should be alert for and avoid such equipment.

ADULT acknowledges on ADULT's and/or MINOR's behalf that falls and collisions occur and **INJURIES or DEATH** may result from participation in the ACTIVITIES. As a participant in the ACTIVITIES, Participant will be involved in racing, competition, performance or special event programs. Undersigned recognizes, understands and agrees that participation in such programs is more hazardous and dangerous than recreational skiing or other similar recreational activity. Undersigned represents and assures the Resort that Participant has the skills, conditioning and dexterity required to participate in the ACTIVITIES. Undersigned further agrees that as a participant in a racing, competition, performance or special event program, Participant is a competitor at all times, whether warming up, practicing for competition or in competition. Undersigned acknowledges that Participant will always be provided an opportunity to conduct a reasonable inspection of the training, competition, event or race course and make his/her own decision about whether to participate, given the conditions at the time. Undersigned understands, agrees and represents that Participant will always engage in reasonable inspection and decision-making pertaining to participation. Undersigned freely **assumes all risk of all course conditions** including, but not limited to, course design, course construction, course layout, course terrain, course jumps, features and obstacles and course maintenance. Participation in the ACTIVITY shall not in any way eliminate the risks of skiing or risks involved in riding ski lifts. **RECOGNIZING AND ACCEPTING THE ABOVE RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES, ADULT VOLUNTARILY CHOOSES TO TAKE PART IN THE RACING, COMPETITION, PERFORMANCE OR SPECIAL EVENT PROGRAM OR VOLUNTARILY CHOOSES TO ALLOW MINOR TO TAKE PART IN THE RACING, COMPETITION, PERFORMANCE OR SPECIAL EVENT PROGRAM.**

By signing this Agreement ADULT on his/her own behalf and, if applicable, on behalf of MINOR, acknowledges the risks described above and the inherent risks associated with the ACTIVITIES and, as a condition to Participant engaging in the ACTIVITIES, ADULT on his/her own behalf and, if applicable, on behalf of MINOR agrees to (1) **ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH** to Participant while or as a result of

participating in the ACTIVITIES; (2) RELEASE, and NOT SUE, MAKE ANY CLAIMS OR FILE ANY ACTIONS against Steamboat Ski & Resort Corp., Intrawest US Holdings, Inc., the United States Forest Service, all ACTIVITY sponsors, their insurance carriers, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, shareholders, members, representatives, assignees, employees, volunteers, agents, as well as any operator of a venue for an ACTIVITY, and all equipment manufacturers and distributors (hereinafter the "Indemnified Parties") that are based on or that result from, in whole or in part, participation in the ACTIVITIES; (3) INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS THE INDEMNIFIED PARTIES FROM ANY LIABILITY, claims, demands, actions, and causes of actions whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage or injury, including death, that may be sustained by Participant or caused to others or their property by Participant while taking part in the ACTIVITIES, including, but not limited to, those injuries and damages caused by negligence and/or breach of warranty, express or implied, on the part of the Indemnified Parties. Undersigned agrees to pay all costs including attorney's fees incurred by any Indemnified Party in defending a claim or suit brought by or on behalf of Undersigned.

Undersigned gives Resort permission to take and use photographs, video recordings, or movies of Participant taken during the ACTIVITIES worldwide for any purpose in promoting the Resort or related activities of the Resort in print, brochures, advertisements, films or videos and on broadcast presentations of any sort.

ADULT authorizes the RESORT and/or its authorized personnel to call for medical care, treatment and/or procedures (collectively "Care"), for PARTICIPANT or to transport PARTICIPANT to a medical facility or hospital if, in the opinion of such personnel, medical attention is needed. ADULT agrees that upon PARTICIPANT'S transport to a facility or hospital that the RESORT and its personnel shall not have any further responsibility for PARTICIPANT. ADULT also consents to the Care given by an emergency caregiver or under the instructions and directions of a licensed physician. It is understood that reasonable efforts will be made to notify ADULT at the earliest possible time in the event such Care is undertaken for a MINOR. ADULT knowingly and voluntarily consents in advance to such Care to encourage the physicians and the RESORT to exercise its best judgment in undertaking such Care. Further, ADULT agrees on behalf of ADULT and MINOR to pay all costs associated with such Care and transportation provided for PARTICIPANT and to indemnify and hold harmless the INDEMNIFIED PARTIES from any resulting costs.

In consideration for participating in the ACTIVITIES, Undersigned agrees that ALL claims for injury, property damage and/or death arising from ADULT and/or MINOR's participation in the ACTIVITIES shall be **GOVERNED BY COLORADO LAW** without reference to any choice of law rules and **EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION** shall be in the **District Court in Routt County or in Federal Court for the District of Colorado**.

This Agreement shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be enforceable. The undersigned parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is also signing this Agreement on behalf of MINOR and that MINOR shall be bound by all the terms of this Agreement. Undersigned understands and agrees that if this Agreement is not signed on behalf of MINOR, the MINOR would not be permitted to participate in the ACTIVITIES. This Agreement shall be binding upon Undersigned's assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives.
