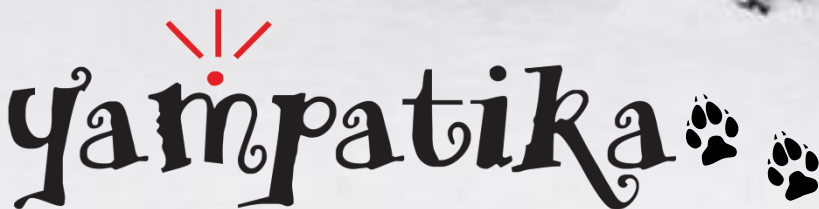
Ski with a Naturalist 1:30 - 2:30
